Q: Who can attend?

A: Camp is limited to 12 boys & girls age 13-16.

Q: How much does Trout Camp cost?

A: The price for Trout Camp is \$550 per person and includes your 4 night stay at Quimby Country, meals, transportation to off site fishing locations and all your instruction.

Q: Does it matter if I've never fly fished before?

A: Not at all. There is no previous experience required, just a willingness to participate and enthusiasm for learning.

Q: What if I don't have my own fly fishing equipment?

A: No problem we'll have equipment here for you to use during camp.

Q: Will the classes and activities take place inside or outside?

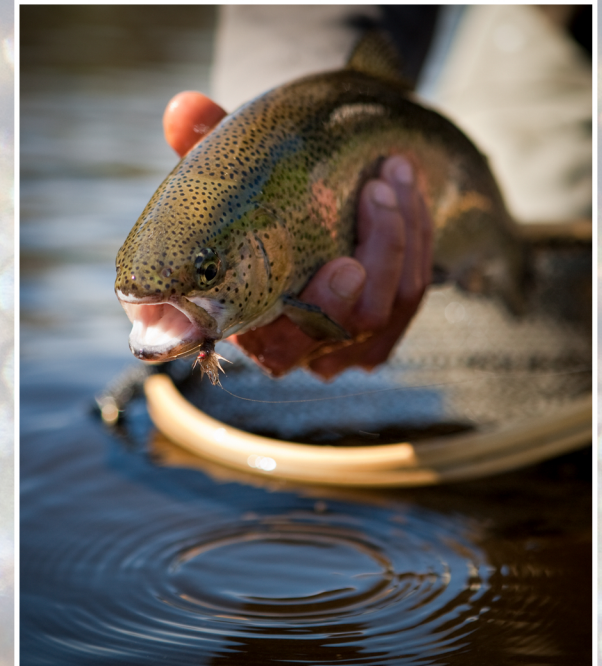
A: Both, but the majority of our time will be spent outdoors actively engaged in learning to fish.
